ORDER TERMINATING PROBATION

On January 20, 2009, the Maryland State Board of Physicians (the “Maryland Board”) and Shelly-Ann V. Hope, M.D., entered into a Consent Order, wherein the Board concluded, as a matter of law, that Dr. Hope was disciplined and placed on probation by the North Carolina Medical Board (the “North Carolina Board”) for an act that would be grounds for disciplinary action in Maryland.¹ Dr. Hope’s license to practice medicine in Maryland was suspended, with the suspension immediately stayed, and placed on probation with the same terms, conditions, and duration imposed by the North Carolina Board. Dr. Hope has fully and satisfactorily complied with all of the terms and conditions of probation and the probation imposed by the North Carolina Board has been terminated. It is thus hereby

ORDERED that the probation and the stayed suspension imposed by the January 20, 2009 Consent Order is **TERMINATED**; and it is further

ORDERED that this is a public document.
