
**ORDER TERMINATING PROBATION AND
AMENDING ORDER OF REINSTATEMENT**

On October 26, 2016, Disciplinary Panel B (“Panel B”) of the Maryland State Board of Physicians issued a Ruling on Petition for Reinstatement and Order of Reinstatement that reinstated the Maryland Medical license of George A. Oyler, M.D., and placed him on probation for a minimum of three (3) years subject to terms and conditions. The Order further stipulated that that if the Respondent satisfactorily completed one (1) year of probation, Panel B would consider a petition for early termination of the probation provided that the Respondent entered into a disposition agreement with the Board or Panel and remained enrolled in monitoring through MPHP¹ for the duration that he possesses an active license in Maryland. Dr. Oyler has fully and satisfactorily complied with the terms and conditions of the Ruling on Petition for Reinstatement and Order of Reinstatement, one (1) year has passed, and Dr. Oyler has agreed to remain enrolled in monitoring through MPRP. It is thus hereby

ORDERED that the probation imposed by the October 26, 2016 Ruling on Petition for Reinstatement and Order of Reinstatement is **TERMINATED**; and it is further

ORDERED this is a public document.

¹ Disposition agreements traditionally require respondents to enroll in the Maryland Professional Rehabilitation Program (“MPRP”) not the Maryland Professional Health Program (“MPHP”). Panel B hereby amends the Order of Reinstatement to clarify that the monitoring will be through MPRP and not MPHP.
