ORDER TERMINATING PROBATION

On December 12, 2014, the Maryland State Board of Physicians (the “Maryland Board”) and Mallikarjun R. Thatipelli, M.D., entered into a Consent Order, wherein the Maryland Board concluded, as a matter of law, that Dr. Thatipelli was disciplined by the Medical Board of California (the “California Board”) for an act that would be grounds for disciplinary action in Maryland.¹ The Maryland Board revoked Dr. Thatipelli’s license, with the revocation immediately stayed, and placed him on probation until the California Board deemed it appropriate to terminate the probationary terms and conditions it had imposed upon him. Dr. Thatipelli has fully and satisfactorily complied with all of the terms and conditions of the Consent Order and the probation imposed by the California Board has been terminated. It is thus hereby

ORDERED that the probation imposed by the December 12, 2014 Consent Order are **TERMINATED**²; and it is further

ORDERED that this is a public document.
