CALL TO ORDER

Dr. Freas called the meeting to order at 9:03 a.m.

BOARD COUNSEL REPORT

Board Counsel asked the Board to consider the following recommendations from the Polysomnography Professional Standards Committee (PPSC) in response to two scope of practice inquiries.

1. The PPSC recommended that the Board consider the administering of the Itamar WatchPat device as the practice of polysomnography if a third party administered the

test, but if patients administered the test to themselves, it would not be considered the practice of polysomnography.

2. The PPSC recommended that individuals licensed and residing in another state would have to be licensed as a polysomnographic technologist in Maryland in order to score sleep study tests on Maryland patients.

*On a motion made by Dr. Rosenstein, and seconded by Ms. Schaerr, the Board voted unanimously to **APPROVE** the recommendations of the Polysomnography Professional Standards Committee.*

Unfinished Business

Nawaf Aslam-Pervez, M.D. – Postgraduate Training Equivalency

At the June 14, 2017 meeting, Panel A reviewed Dr. Aslam-Pervez's postgraduate training in oral-maxillofacial surgery to determine if it is equivalent to at least one year of ACGME-accredited training. Panel A voted not to accept Dr. Aslam-Pervez's postgraduate training equivalency request and recommended that he obtain another year of postgraduate training.

At the June 28, 2017 meeting, both Panels reviewed Dr. Aslam-Pervez's request to accept his oral-maxillofacial surgery postgraduate training as equivalent to at least one year of ACGME-accredited training.

On a motion made by Mr. Brody, and seconded by Ms. Schaerr, the Board voted 9 for and 10 against with 1 abstention to not accept Dr. Aslam Pervez's oral-maxillo facial surgery postgraduate training as equivalent to at least one year of ACGME-accredited training.

The Board then voted to postpone his request until the July 26, 2017 full Board meeting.
