## ORDER TERMINATING PROBATION

On December 9, 2024, Disciplinary Panel B (the "Panel") of the Maryland State Board of Physicians (the "Board") and Benjamin Frizner, M.D., entered into a Consent Order, wherein the Panel concluded, as a matter of law, that Dr. Frizner was guilty of unprofessional conduct in the practice of medicine, in violation of Health Occ. § 14-404(a)(3)(ii); willfully made or filed a false report or record in the practice of medicine, in violation of Health Occ. § 14-404(a)(11); and willfully submitted false statements to collect fees for which services were not provided, in violation of Health Occ. § 14-404(a)(23). Dr. Frizner was reprimanded, placed on probation for a minimum period of one (1) year, ordered to successfully complete a course in ethics within six (6) months and pay a civil fine of fifteen thousand dollars (\$15,000.00) within one (1) year.

Dr. Frizner has fully and satisfactorily complied with all of the terms and conditions of probation imposed by the December 9, 2024 Consent Order and one (1) year has passed.

It is thus, by the Panel, hereby

**ORDERED** that the probation and probationary terms and conditions imposed by the December 9, 2024 Consent Order are **TERMINATED**; and it is further

ORDERED that the reprimand remains in effect; and it is further
