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### ORDER TERMINATING PROBATION

On March 4, 2024, Disciplinary Panel A (the “Panel”) of the Maryland State Board of Physicians (the “Board”) and Kak Rae Kim, M.D., entered into a Consent Order, wherein the Panel concluded, as a matter of law, that Dr. Kim was guilty of unprofessional conduct in the practice of medicine.<sup>1</sup> Dr. Kim was reprimanded and placed on probation for a minimum period of one (1) year with certain terms and conditions, including that he enroll in the Maryland Professional Rehabilitation Program (“MPRP”) and comply with all of MPRP’s referrals and recommendations, complete courses in professionalism and anger management within six (6) months, and pay a fine of five thousand dollars (\$5,000.00) within one (1) year.

Dr. Kim has fully and satisfactorily complied with all of the terms and conditions of probation imposed by the Consent Order and one (1) year has passed.

It is thus, by the Panel, hereby

**ORDERED** that the probation and probationary terms and conditions imposed by the March 4, 2024 Consent Order are **TERMINATED**; and it is further
