CONSENT ORDER

PROCEDURAL BACKGROUND

The Maryland Board of Physicians (the "Maryland Board") received information that Gene Hyung Lee, M.D., (the "Respondent") License Number D0086530, was disciplined by the Wyoming Board of Medicine (the "Wyoming Board"). In an "Order Granting Motion for Default; Order of Suspension; Order of Reprimand; Order Imposing Civil Fine" (the "Order") dated May 8, 2025, the Wyoming Board issued a ninety (90) day suspension of the Respondent's medical license, reprimand, and assessed a fine in the amount of \$500.00.

Based on the above referenced Wyoming Board sanction, the Maryland Board has grounds to charge the Respondent with violating the following provisions of the Maryland Medical Practice Act (the "Act"), under H.O. § 14-404(a):

- (a) Subject to the hearing provisions of § 14-405 of this subtitle, a disciplinary panel, on the affirmative vote of a majority of the quorum of the disciplinary panel, may reprimand any licensee, place any licensee on probation, or suspend or revoke a license if the licensee:
 - (21) Is disciplined by a licensing or disciplinary authority or convicted or disciplined by a court of any state or country or disciplined by any branch of the United States uniformed services or the Veterans' Administration for an act that would be grounds for disciplinary action under this section,

Disciplinary Panel A ("Panel A") has determined that the acts for which the Respondent was disciplined in Wyoming would be grounds for disciplinary action under H.O. § 14-404(a). The grounds for disciplinary action under H.O. § 14-404(a) are as follows:

- (33) Fails to cooperate with a lawful investigation conducted by the Board or a disciplinary panel;
- (43) Except for the licensure process described under Subtitle 3A of this title, violates any provision of this title, any rule or regulation adopted by the Board, or any State or federal law pertaining to the practice of medicine;

Health Occ. § 14-316 and Code of Maryland Regulations ("COMAR")

The pertinent provision of H.O. §14-316 provides:

- (c) Applications for renewal.-- Before the license expires, the licensee periodically may renew it for an additional term, if the licensee:
 - (iv) Submits to the Board:

* * *

2. Satisfactory evidence of compliance with any continuing education requirements set under this section for license renewal.

The pertinent provisions of COMAR under 10.32.01 provide:

- .08 Renewals
 - H. A licensee applying for renewal shall complete the CME requirements as defined in Regulation .10 of this chapter.
- .10 Continuing Medical Education
 - C. Requirements.

- (1) In accordance with the requirements specified in §C(2) of this regulation, an applicant shall earn at least 50 credit hours of Category I CME during a 2-year period.

- D. On the application form for renewal or reinstatement, the applicant shall attest to the fact that the applicant has completed the CME requirement.

Based on the action taken by the Wyoming Board, the Respondent agrees to enter into this Consent Order with Panel A, consisting of Procedural Background, Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law, Order and Consent.

FINDINGS OF FACT

Panel A makes the following findings of fact:

- 1. At all times relevant hereto, the Respondent was a physician licensed to practice medicine in the State of Maryland. The Respondent was initially licensed in Maryland on or about December 13, 2018.
- 2. In 2023, the Respondent renewed his Wyoming medical license, in which he confirmed that he had completed the required continuing medical education ("CME").
- 3. The Respondent was randomly audited for completion of the required CME credit hours from July 2020 to June 30, 2023. Wyoming Board "staff sent multiple letters" to the Respondent requesting documentation for the completion of his 2020 through 2023 CME credit hours, but no response was received.
- 4. Wyoming Board staff filed a "Petition and Complaint Notice of Opportunity to Answer Notice of Procedure Notice of Opportunity for Informal Resolution," but the Respondent failed to respond or appear for the interview.

^{1 &}quot;2-year period" means: (i) For license renewal, the 2 years preceding the expiration of the physician license or (ii) For license reinstatement, the 2 years preceding the date of the submission of the application for reinstatement of the physician license. COMAR 10.32.01.10A(2)(a).

5. By Order dated May 8, 2025, the Wyoming Board issued a ninety (90) day suspension of the Respondent's medical license, reprimand, and assessed a fine in the amount of \$500.00.

A copy of the Wyoming Board Order is attached hereto.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

Based on the foregoing Findings of Fact, Panel A concludes as a matter of law that the Respondent is subject to discipline under Health Occ. § 14-404(a)(21) for the disciplinary action taken by the Wyoming Board against the Respondent for an act or acts that would be grounds for disciplinary action under Health Occ. §14-404(a)(33): fails to cooperate with a lawful investigation conducted by the Board or a disciplinary panel, and (43) except for the licensure process described under Subtitle 3A of this title, violates any provision of this title, any rule or regulation adopted by the Board, or any State or federal law pertaining to the practice of medicine, in violation of Health Occ. § 14-316 and Code of Maryland Regulations.

ORDER

It is, thus, by Panel A, hereby:

ORDERED that the Respondent's medical license in Maryland is hereby SUSPENDED for ninety (90) days from the date of this Order; and it is further

ORDERED that the Respondent's medical license is hereby REPRIMANDED; and it is further

ORDERED that the Respondent shall comply with all terms and conditions of the Wyoming Board Order dated May 8, 2025; and it is further

ORDERED that this Consent Order shall not be amended or modified and future

requests for modification will not be considered; and it is further,

ORDERED that the effective date of the Consent Order is the date the Consent Order is signed by the Executive Director of the Board or her designee. The Executive Director or her designee signs the Consent Order on behalf of the disciplinary panel which has imposed the terms and conditions of this Consent Order; and it is further

ORDERED that the Respondent is responsible for all costs incurred in fulfilling the terms and conditions of this Consent Order; and it is further

ORDERED that, if the Respondent allegedly fails to comply with any term or condition imposed by this Consent Order, the Respondent shall be given notice and an opportunity for a hearing. If the disciplinary panel determines there is a genuine dispute as to a material fact, the hearing shall be before an Administrative Law Judge of the Office of Administrative Hearings followed by an exceptions process before a disciplinary panel; and if the disciplinary panel determines there is no genuine dispute as to a material fact, the Respondent shall be given a show cause hearing before a disciplinary panel; and it is further

ORDERED that, after the appropriate hearing, if the disciplinary panel determines that the Respondent has failed to comply with any term or condition imposed by this Consent Order, the disciplinary panel may reprimand the Respondent, place the Respondent on probation with appropriate terms and conditions, or suspend Respondent's license with appropriate terms and conditions, or revoke the Respondent's license. The disciplinary panel may, in addition to one or more of the sanctions set forth above, impose a civil monetary fine on the Respondent; and it is further

ORDERED that this Consent Order is a public document. See Health Occ. §§1-607, 14-411.1(b)(2) and Gen. Prov. §4-333(b)(6).


