## ORDER

### PROCEDURAL BACKGROUND

On March 15, 2024, **VICTOR M. TSENG, M.D.** (the “Respondent”), License Number D0099866, was licensed to practice medicine in Maryland through the Interstate Medical Licensure Compact (“IMLC”). The Respondent’s license is active through September 30, 2025 and his state of principal license is Georgia.

The IMLC law states that “[i]f a license granted to a physician by the member board in the state of principal license is revoked, surrendered or relinquished in lieu of discipline, or suspended, then all licenses issued to the physician by member boards shall automatically be placed . . . on the same status.” Md. Code Ann., Health Occ. §14-3A-01, Section 10(b).

On April 8, 2024, the Respondent’s license issued by the Georgia Composite Medical Board (“Georgia Board”) was summarily suspended. Pursuant to Health Occ. §14-3A-01, Section 10(b), on April 26, 2024, the Maryland Board **suspended** the Respondent’s license.

On or about November 13, 2024, the Georgia Board issued a Final Decision and Order (“Order”) revoking the Respondent’s license in Georgia. Pursuant to Health Occ. §14-3A-01, Section 10(b), the Maryland Board is required to automatically **revoke** the Respondent’s license to practice medicine in the State of Maryland.

**ORDER**

It is, by a majority of the quorum of Disciplinary Panel A of the Maryland State Board of Physicians, hereby:

**ORDERED** that, pursuant Md. Code Ann., Health Occ. § 14-3A-01, Section 10(b), the license to practice medicine in the State of Maryland of **VICTOR M. TSENG, M.D.** (the “Respondent”), License Number D0099866, is hereby **REVOKED**, and it is further

**ORDERED** that this is an Order of Disciplinary Panel A, and as such, is a **PUBLIC DOCUMENT**. See Md. Code Ann., Health Occ. §§ 1-607, 14-411.1(b)(2) and Gen. Provisions § 4-333(b)(6).
