## ORDER TERMINATING PROBATION

On June 5, 2024, Disciplinary Panel A (the "Panel") of the Maryland State Board of Physicians (the "Board") and Christopher Larrimore, D.O., entered into a Consent Order, wherein the Panel concluded, as a matter of law, that Dr. Larrimore was guilty of unprofessional conduct in the practice of medicine, in violation of Health Occ. § 14-404(a)(3)(ii)<sup>1</sup> of the Health Occupations Article.

Pursuant to the Consent Order, Dr. Larrimore was reprimanded and placed on probation for a minimum period of one (1) year with the following terms and conditions: 1) enrolls and complies with all of the Maryland Professional Rehabilitation Program's ("MPRP") referrals, rules, and requirements; and 2) successfully complete a course in Ethics within six (6) months from the effective date of the Consent Order.

Dr. Larrimore has fully and satisfactorily complied with all of the terms and conditions of the probation imposed by the June 5, 2024, Consent Order, and one (1) year has passed.

It is thus, by the Panel, hereby

**ORDERED** that the probation and probationary terms and conditions imposed by the June 5, 2024, Consent Order are **TERMINATED**; and it is further
