### **CONSENT ORDER**

On or about March 24, 2025, the Maryland State Board of Physicians (the “Board”) opened an investigation of **PRISCILLA ATSWEI ANUM, Radiographer** (the “Respondent”). Based on its investigation, the Board determined that it has grounds to charge the Respondent with violating the Maryland Radiation Therapy, Radiography, Nuclear Medicine Technology, and Radiology Assistance Act (the “Act”), Md. Code Ann., Health Occ. (“Health Occ.”) §§ 14-5B-01 *et seq.* (2021 Repl. Vol. & 2024 Supp.).

The pertinent provisions of the Act provide:

**Health Occ. § 14-5B-01. Definitions.**

....

- (o) “Practice radiography” means to use ionizing radiation to:
  - (1) Demonstrate portions of the human body to assist in the diagnosis or localization of disease or injury[.]

**Health Occ. § 14-5B-17. Unauthorized practice prohibited**

....

#### **Radiography**

- (c) Except as otherwise provided in this subtitle, a person may not practice, attempt to practice, or offer to practice radiography in this State unless licensed to practice radiography by the Board.

The Respondent is entering into this Consent Order, consisting of Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law, Order, and Consent.

### **FINDINGS OF FACT**

Panel B finds the following:

1. The Respondent is licensed to practice radiography in the state of Virginia.
2. On or about March 24, 2025, the Board received an Allied Health Application for Initial Licensure-Radiographer (the “Application”) from the Respondent.
3. In the Application, the Respondent stated that since August 2024, she was employed<sup>1</sup> as a radiology technologist at an urgent care center (the “Center”)<sup>2</sup> located in Steeplechase, Maryland.
4. Based on the information in the Application, the Board initiated an investigation.
5. The Board subpoenaed and received the Respondent’s personnel records from the Center which documented, among other things, that the Respondent performed x-rays to diagnose injuries while unlicensed in Maryland and working at the Center on or around August 6, 2024, through April 17, 2025.<sup>3</sup>

### **CONCLUSIONS OF LAW**

Based on the foregoing findings of fact, Disciplinary Panel B concludes as a matter of law that the Respondent practiced radiography without a license, in violation of Md. Code Ann., Health Occ. § 14-5B-17(c).

<sup>2</sup> To ensure confidentiality and privacy, the name of the health care facility will not be disclosed in this document.

<sup>3</sup> On or around April 17, 2025, the Board issued the Respondent a license to practice radiography.

## ORDER

It is thus by a majority of a quorum of Disciplinary Panel B of the Board hereby:

**ORDERED** that within **ONE YEAR** of the effective date of this Consent Order, the Respondent, **PRISCILLA ANUM**, shall pay a civil fine of **TWO THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$2,000)**. The payment shall be by money order or bank certified check made payable to the Maryland Board of Physicians and mailed to P.O. Box 37217, Baltimore, Maryland 21297; and it is further

**ORDERED** that the effective date of the Consent Order is the date the Consent Order is signed by the Executive Director of the Board or her designee. The Executive Director signs the Consent Order on behalf of the disciplinary panel which has imposed the terms and conditions of the Consent Order; and it is further

**ORDERED** that this Consent Order is a public document. See Md. Code Ann., Health Occ. §§ 1-607, 14-411.1(b)(2) and Gen. Prov. § 4-333(b)(6).

I voluntarily enter into and agree to comply with the terms and conditions set forth in the Consent Order as a resolution of the charges. I waive any right to contest the Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law and Order set out in the Consent Order. I waive all rights to appeal this Consent Order.

I sign this Consent Order, without reservation, and fully understand the language and meaning of its terms.
