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ORDER

On April 25, 2024, the Maryland State Board of Physicians (the "Board) and Madel Macapagal, entered into a Consent Order, wherein the Board concluded, as a matter of law, that Ms. Macapagal violated § 14-5C-17(a)(3) and § 14-5C-17(a)(10) ¹ of the Health Occupations Article by failing to obtain the requisite continuing medical education credits and willfully filing a false report or record in the practice of polysomnography. Ms. Macapagal was ordered to pay a civil fine of one thousand dollars (\$1,000.00) within **ONE (1) YEAR** and required to obtain the required 20 credit mandatory hours of Category I CME for her 2025 medical license renewal and the outstanding 10 hours of the Category I CME credits that were not obtained during her 2023 renewal. Ms. Macapagal has paid the \$1,000.00 civil fine and has provided verification to the Board that she completed all thirty (30) hours of the required Category I CME credits.

It is thus, by the Panel, hereby

ORDERED that the fine and Category I CME credit requirement imposed by the April 25, 2024 Consent Order have been **SATISFIED**; and it is further

ORDERED that the reprimand remains in effect; and it is further **ORDERED** that this is a public document.
