APPROVAL OF MINUTES

On a motion made by Ms. Wilson and seconded by Dr. Klune, the Committee unanimously approved the December 4, 2024, Open Meeting Minutes.

LEGISLATION, REGULATIONS, AND POLICY UPDATES

Mr. Tran presented the PAAC with the responses the Board received from public solicitation of comments for the update of the list of Advanced Duties. Mr. Tran reminded the PAAC that Advanced Duties are defined as medical acts that require additional training beyond the basic physician assistant education program required for licensure. He also stated that any recommendation to remove an Advanced Duty must be supported with evidence that the advanced medical act is now taught and trained as part of the standard PA education program.

After reviewing the public comments, on a motion by Dr. Kuruppu and seconded by Dr. Roca, the Committee unanimously voted to recommend that the Board only remove "IUD Removal" from the Advanced Duties list as it is not an advanced duty.
